OFFERS CAN BE GIVEN TO YOUR LOCAL ELEVATOR FOR THE OVER NIGHT TRADING SESSION.

Example: You want to sell bushels that were harvested after the market close. Give your local coop the
 the quantity and price you want, an order will be placed in the over night session. If the order is filled,
 your sale is complete. Orders will need to be placed with the coop by 5:00 p.m. 1,000 bu. minimum.

FORWARD SALE AND DELIVERY CONTRACTS CAN BE MADE DURING THE TRADING SESSION AT
 YOUR LOCAL ELEVATOR. Example: If you want to sell bushels that you know will be harvested in the
 next few days, you can make a contract and price those at anytime during the trading session. Delivery
 will need to be made by July 15th.

15 DAY GRACE PERIOD ON STORAGE CHARGES. THEREAFTER, STORAGE REVERTS BACK TO
 DAY OF DEPOSIT. STORAGE RATE 132/1000 CENTS PER BU. PER DAY (48.18 cents per bu per yr)
