



Scholarship & Internship Program Information

Scholarship Qualifications:

This scholarship will be awarded to college students in their Junior (3rd year) and/or Senior (4th year) of college. They must be in the fields of Agronomy, Animal Science, Ag Business or other Ag related field acceptable to the scholarship committee. The students must be enrolled as a full time (12 credit hours minimum) student at Fort Hays State University. Rangeland Cooperatives, Inc. will reimburse tuition and fees up to \$2,200 per semester provided that the student maintains a 2.5 GPA and completes the summer internship program. Funds will be made available to FHSU at the beginning of each semester.

Internship:

The internship will be a paid internship and consists of working at Rangeland Cooperatives, Inc. the summer between the sophomore and junior year. The internship will consist of learning the cooperative business principals. This will be achieved by rotating within the departments and shadowing the department managers for a limited time. The intern will also work in each department as can be scheduled within the allotted time for the summer. This schedule will be established by the General Manager. A report and presentation will be required to be given to the management staff and Board of Directors at the end of summer.
