

# TIPS TO PROTECT YOUR ENGINES



Proper tank maintenance helps ensure your fuel supply stays clean and free of harmful contaminants in your storage tank — and remains that way until it reaches your fuel system. Removing water, sediment and other impurities from the storage tank prevents them from entering your fuel system where they can lead to corrosion, filter plugging, and ice formation that severely hampers engine performance.

## Conduct fall tank maintenance

- Drain and remove water and contaminants (every 3 months)
- Change bulk storage tank filters (at least twice a year)
- Clean pump screens (regularly)
- Clean tanks (annually)
- Ensure tank is tilted to direct water and debris away from outlet
- Replace vehicle tank filters (as recommended by manufacturer)
- Drain condensation (periodically) if vehicle tank filter has drain valve
- Check caps, sumps and vents for integrity and proper functioning
