US Sample Grade:

1. Does not meet the requirements for the grades US Nos. 1, 2, 3, 4 or 5; or
2. Has a musty, sour or commercially objectionable foreign odor, or
3. Is heating or otherwise of distinctly low quality.

Broken corn and foreign material - All matter that passes readily through a 12/64 round-hole sieve and all matter other than corn that remains in the sieved sample after sieving according to procedures prescribed in FGIS instructions.

Damaged kernels - Kernels and pieces of corn kernels that are badly ground-damaged, badly weather-damaged, diseased, frost-damaged, germ-damaged, heat-damaged, insect-bored, mold-damaged, sprout-damaged or otherwise materially damaged.

Heat-damaged kernels - Kernels and pieces of corn kernels that are materially discolored and damaged by heat.

Moisture Requirements - 15.0 on *Sell* or *Contract* : 14.0 on *Delayed Price* : 14.0 on *Storage-*

Dry & Return - Must be hauled home immediately or incur .15 cents/bushel charge.

*There are various discounts for each grain that is not included on this sheet, but are still applicable when determining grain values.
