Several questions have surfaced about M&M's fertilizer plant in Franklin. Could the same thing happen that occured in West? What ingredients are stored in the Franklin Plant? Are we safe in the Franklin Community?

The two fertilizer ingredients that probably caused the blast in West are Ammonia Nitrate and Anhydrous Ammonia. Neither is stored at the M&M plant in Franklin. They are not used in the manufacturing process at M&M!
